



JOB DESCRIPTION

Position: Geologist, Engineer, or Environmental Scientist

Company: A-Zone Environmental Services, LLC, an environmental remediation, demolition, earthwork and field services company, is seeking a Geologist, Engineer, or Environmental Scientist with 2+ years of work experience to join our growing team. The position is located in Charles Town.

Job Description: The position involves operating independently on field and office project tasks and working in support of senior staff on large projects at a wide range of multidisciplinary environmental remediation projects throughout the county. Primary office responsibilities will be preparation of monitoring reports, supporting preparation of technical reports, organizing and coordinating field events, managing project data, and providing support on proposals. Field work will include groundwater and soil sampling, drilling oversight, construction/demolition supervision, and remediation system operations and maintenance.

Required knowledge, skills, and abilities:

- Bachelor's or master's degree in geology or hydrogeology, environmental science, environmental engineering, or related field.
- Willingness to travel up to 50% locally and out of state for projects.
- At least 2 years of experience in the environmental field with field experience in some or all of the following: groundwater, soil, and vapor sampling; remediation system operations and maintenance; construction/demolition oversight; and drilling oversight.
- Must be able to work and think independently.
- Must possess excellent written and oral communication skills and must work well with other staff and clients.
- 40-hr HAZWOPER certification or the ability to attain this certification.
- First Aid/CPR certifications preferred.
- Valid driver's license is required and a safe driving record.

Physical Requirements: Work may be performed under extreme weather conditions including hot and cold ambient temperatures. Tasks involve bending, lifting, walking, carrying and using a force equal to lifting 50 pounds. Employment is dependent upon passing drug screening and physical examination by medical professional for the anticipated work requirements.

Salary: This is a salaried position. Typical work schedule is 40 hours per week. Pay is dependent upon qualifications and experience.
